Chairman Tom Champaigne opened the meeting at 4:00 p.m. Members present were Mark LeSage, Donald Korhonen, and Dennis Smet. Absent were Gerald Anderson, Dean Baillie, Jennis Swenson, and Tim Follis. Michael Kinnick, representative of NW Regional Planning Commission was also present.

Michael questioned whether the town board had approved the public participation plan, which was to be reviewed by the committee and adopted by the board. Since this had not been done yet, the committee will look it over at the end of the meeting so it can be brought up at the next board meeting in May. After the town board adopts and signs the plan, it should be forwarded to NW Regional Planning Commission to be included in the town's final comprehensive plan. He noted the goals and objectives look fine.


The committee looked over the draft copy of transportation, population & demographics, housing, and economic development that had Brule's information added. Michael also submitted copies of natural environment to look over, and had the committee check over a map he submitted, correct any errors, and then add public facilities such as town hall, post office, church, trails, etc. He noted a "goals, objectives and actions table" will be sent to the committee; and before the next meeting, the committee should identify actions, fill in the table using the examples as a guide, and review the natural environment chapter.

The committee reviewed the public participation plan and made changes.
