Comprehensive Planning Committee

Chairman Tom Champaigne opened the meeting at 4:08 p.m. Present were Gerald Anderson, Don Korhonen, Myron Olson, and Marcia Caven. Representing NW Regional Planning Commission was Michael Kinnick. Absent were Jennis Swenson, Mark LeSage, Tim Follis, Dennis Smet and Dean Baillie.

Michael stated he had received the copy of Brule's goals and objectives in May. He submitted draft copies of Brule's comprehensive plan, noting that it is not complete, but we are ahead of all the other municipalities. Other information was the county's zoning setback requirements for land within shorelands and outside shorelands, and portions of draft copies of the county's comprehensive plan.

Michael requested the committee go through Brule's plan to check for errors or missing information and put checks on table 2 of the utilities and community facilities assessment to show future plans. Large and small copies of maps showing Brule's existing land use, all information previously placed on maps by the committee, and environmental constraints were available. The committee looked at the maps for errors, but did not find any. Michael will send a large map showing the main business and residential portion of Brule so the committee can look it over. This was not available for him to bring to the meeting.

The committee will meet to go over everything at a future time. The next meeting with Michael will be in January to look at future land use maps.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
